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1 CONFESS

I confess all known and unknown sin in my family's generational line with the spirit of death including death wish, wishing I'd never been born, suicidal thoughts, suicidal fantasies, suicidal plans, self-hate, self-destruction, death, and oblivion canceling and revoking any ancestral rights to me.

2 FORGIVE OTHERS

4 BREAKING INNER VOWS

Forgive me for making inner vows even in the womb, saying "I don't want to live," "I don't want to be born," "I don't want to see," "I don't want to hear," and "I don't want to know." I repent of that now and turn my attention to You, my God. I want to see You. I want to hear You and I want to know You.

5 RENOUNCE

I renounce and sever all agreements, covenants, ties, dedications and oaths made with the spirit of death, in the name of Jesus Christ, by the power of His blood and the authority He has given to me. I receive the fullness of Your plans, blessing and spiritual inheritance in my family line.

6 TAKE AUTHORITY

I command the spirit of death, and all other demons behind: wishing I'd never been born, suicidal thoughts, suicidal fantasies, suicidal plans, self-hate, self-destruction, suicide, death and oblivion to leave me now in the Name of Jesus Christ, and by the power of His blood, and go where Jesus would send you.

7 I RECEIVE

I choose to acknowledge, believe and receive Your love for me. I receive the plans and destiny You have for my life. I ask for and receive Your peace and power in Jesus name.

ADDITIONAL FORGIVENESS:

I also forgive myself, and no longer judge, criticize, be angry and have condemnation against myself, being hard on myself, You or others. I recognize this as pride. I choose to love myself, to be gentle and kind to myself and to others. I forgive everyone, including myself, for all critical, hateful, abusive, condemning and judgmental thoughts, attitudes, words and behavior, towards You, or towards myself, or others. I renounce all of these things in Jesus Name.

Why did God let this happen?


God is punishing me.
